from our Chief, *Dr. Joebert D. Toledo*

Barely six months ago, I stood before you as newly installed Chief and delivered my vision statement for the organization (i.e. for a more transparent and direct involvement of AQD's highly capable technical staff in the concerns of aquaculture industry). AQD is now in its 33rd year and has made significant strides in generating science-based technologies for breeding and farming of commercially important aquaculture commodities. While significant progress has been achieved in many areas of our research, let us not rest on our laurels. It remains our big challenge to ensure that these science-based technologies are transformed into workable, sustainable production technologies to help improve food security, generate employment and most importantly, provide benefits to a wider section of society.

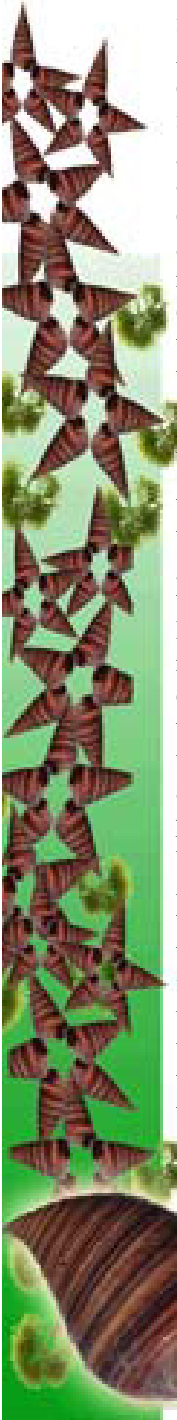
As the year is about to end, let us reflect on what we have achieved so far. The year 2006 saw the initiation of activities towards achieving our goal. Last June, we convened an in-house workshop that reviewed the technologies developed from the Research Division, identified gaps for further research and verification and made plans for dissemination. Following this workshop, AQD went full swing in undertaking research and verification studies aimed at addressing the gaps and also in fine tuning the technologies on seed production and grow-out culture systems for various commodities. Alongside these activities, AQD embarked on initiatives that would facilitate the dissemination and commercialization of viable technologies to farmers, both locally and internationally. Regular training programs and updating of manuals have been continued. At the village level, efforts are also being made to enhance the capacity of our local communities (initially in the provinces of Antique, Capiz and Negros Occidental) through participatory and interdisciplinary approach in the transfer and adoption of technologies developed by AQD on aquaculture and resource management.

Most of the activities conducted in 2006 will be continued in the coming year. Programs will still be commodity-based and will continue to address the technology needs of the region (Philippines and other Southeast Asian countries) particularly in the areas of broodstock development, seed production, and grow-out culture systems. We will continue to generate science-based information through publication in peer-reviewed journals and at the same time put emphasis in verifying and packaging viable technologies for transfer to farmers. Complementary efforts will also be made in fund sourcing to improve our overall financial standing, seeking more collaboration with important research partners and stakeholder groups, and in improving AQD's visibility in the local and international scene. Organization of regular training courses in the areas of our specialization and updating of information materials (with emphasis on manuals) and website will also form an integral part of our activities next year. Under Administration and Finance Division, there will be a review of organization structure, staffing and job classification, salary structure and provision of benefits to staff. It is also expected that systems for performance evaluation and promotion will be in place in the coming year. To ensure quality of our work and high degree of professionalism, the management will also develop operations manual for all stations, will closely monitor the projects, and will enforce rules and regulations and discipline among the staff.

There are challenges ahead; hence, I enjoin everyone to remain focused on what we are trying to achieve as one family. Everyone - from the rank and file staff to leaders of this organization has a crucial role to play. Allow me also to commend the staff for the continued cooperation and dedication to realize our vision.

As we celebrate the birth of our Savior, let us offer to Him the gift of ourselves – our continuing use of the skills and talents God has given us to benefit others. I wish everyone and your families a
